

HOW TO FILL OUT THIS FORM

Please type or print entries clearly in ink. Complete all information requested for each sheep to be registered.

The **BREEDER** is the recorded owner of the dam at time of mating.

The **OWNER** is the recorded owner of the dam at time of birth.

Entries on each form must be from dams & sires owned by the breeder and owner indicated in the right upper corner of the form. If this is not the case, complete a breeding certificate and/or ram lease and attach it to the Registration Form or use the ones included on this registration form.

The **FLOCK NAME** is the name by which all sheep you register are known; for example, your last name or the name of your farm, NOT the pet name of the sheep. Flock names are unique and limited to 14 letters, including spaces. If the name you provide is already in use by another breeder recorded in the Registry, the Registrar will ask you to choose another Flock Name.

The **NUMBER** refers to the individual identification number of the sheep to be registered. Registered Tunis sheep must bear an ear tag, tattoo or ear notches stating this number. Once assigned, this number may not be changed.

Calculate the amount you owe.

Double check all entries and fee calculations.

Make check or money order payable to **NTSRI**.

You may request priority processing by writing "**RUSH**" on your mailing envelope and on the top of the form. Turn around time for "Rush" requests is 2-3 days provided the information on the form is correct and the additional fee for this service is enclosed. **DO NOT PUT RUSH WORK AND ROUTINE WORK ON THE SAME FORM.**

VERIFICATION OF MATING

When the sire or the dam was owned by someone else other than the "OWNER" at the time mating occurred, mating must be verified by a Breeding Certificate or Ram Lease. The person selling a bred ewe or providing a ram for lease may complete the appropriate section below and give this registration form to the new owner of the ewe(s) or to the person leasing the ram. This form would then be used to file the first registrations for lambs resulting from the mating. Additional offspring may be registered by simply using a blank form as the Breeding Certificate or Ram Lease is kept in the permanent records of the Registry. Alternately, a Breeding Certificate or Ram Lease form may be provided to the new owner. A Breeding Certificate records exposure up to 157 days (5.25 months) from the last day of mating. Offspring born during this period would be eligible for registration. Breeding Certificates and Ram Leases must bear the original signature of the person issuing the certificate or the lease.
