Bartholomew 04-99 and his littermate sister 04-100 (Lot #14) are what I have been telling folks for quite some time are "the best pair of lambs I have ever raised". They were both part of my show flocks in 2005 and 2006, and in fact they both won their classes at Louisville as lambs and returned to place 2nd and 3rd the next year as yearlings. They both won champion honors several times over those two years as well.

Of all the Tunis I have bred he may very well be the best. Take a good look at his straight top, high square dock, great feet and legs and how high his neck is set on his shoulders. He is the sire of almost all of the lambs in this sale.

Honestly, if someone came up to me and asked which sheep they should buy in this sale, he would be the one I would suggest. As you can tell I am really high on this guy. I can't wait to see how well he works for his new owner.

"Buckeye" was Reserve Champion Ram at the Ohio State Fair Jr Show. Because he was part of my show flock, he was used on a very small number of ewes. In fact he bred just three of my ewes and one of the Rocks. He is a large framed ram with an extremely long loin. With his brother being the '07 National Champion ram and his dam being named Reserve Champion ewe at Louisville if you are looking for a ram to sire show sheep, take a good look here.
